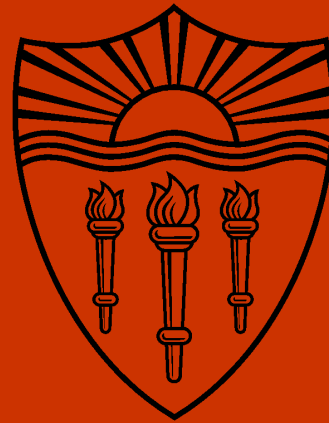


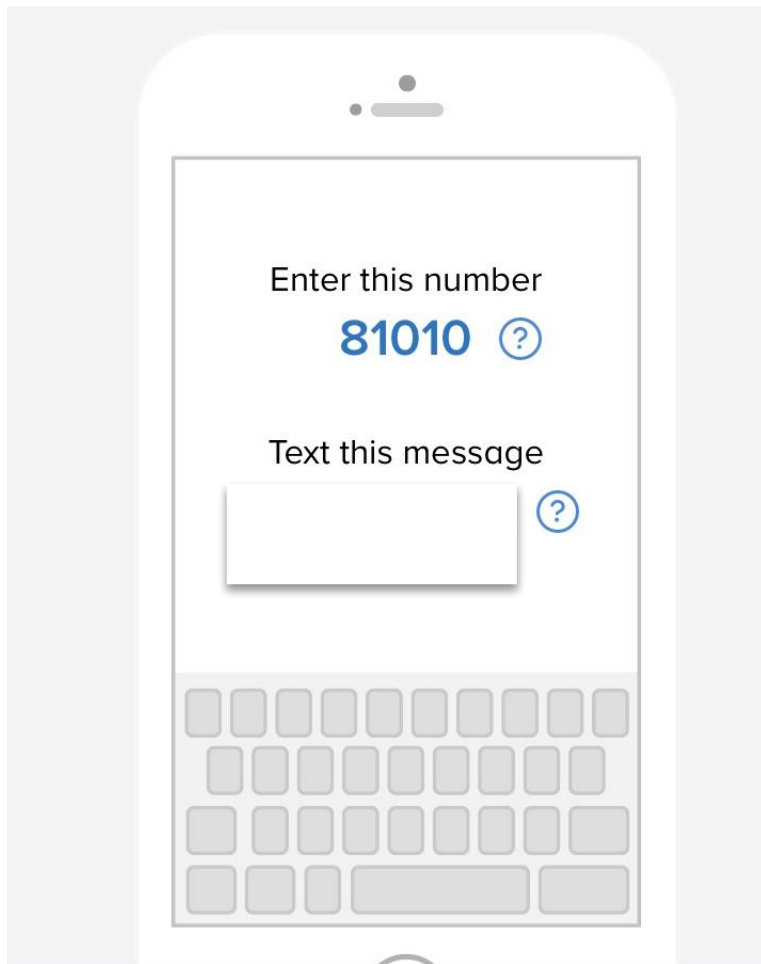

Cellphone Policy

- ❑ **Students cannot have phones on from 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.**
- ❑ **No headphones**
- ❑ **Recreation & Fitness Time** – Cell Phones can be used to listen to music while running the track but not used for calls, texting, face time, Instagram etc...
- ❑ **Study Hall** – Cell Phones can be used to listen to music while studying but not used for calls, texting, face time, Instagram etc...
- ❑ **First Infraction:** Phone will be taken until end of Summer Residential Program and returned to parent after the program

DRESS CODE POLICY



- No bare back shirts
- No bare midriffs to be visible (A bare midriff is defined as when a student raises arms above his/her head and his/her stomach shows)
- No shirts with spaghetti straps (The width of straps is at least 2 inches)
- No visible underwear
- No skin-tight clothing
- No skirts and dresses are to be long enough to touch to the tip of the middle finger when the arm is fully extended

DRESS CODE CONT.

- ❑ **NO** Visible cleavage
- ❑ - Male students must wear shirts at all times
- ❑ **NO** Transparent (see through) clothing
- ❑ **NO** Hats, bandanas, scarfs, hair wraps during class and/or workshop time
- ❑ **NO** Clothing that displays inappropriate language or sexual content or promotes alcohol or drug use



PUBLIC DISPLAY OF AFFECTION (P.D.A.)

- No P.D.A. Rule (Both Genders)
- Behaviors NOT PERMITTED:
 1. Sitting or lying on someone's lap
 2. Kissing or extended hugging
 3. Holding hands

1st Infraction

- Complete Corrective Action Plan and check the 1st Infraction
- Notify Director
- Student meets with Director
- Friday Check-Out Director meets with student and parent(s)
- File in student's file



Corrective Action Plan Cont....

2nd Infraction

- Complete Behavior Modification Contract
- Notify Director
- Student meets with Director, Program Coordinator, RA and discuss Modification Plan
- Friday Check Out Program Coordinator with student and parent(s) to discuss Modification Plan
- File in student's file



Corrective Action Plan Cont....

- 3rd Infraction

- Notify Parents/Guardian
- Expelled from USC Summer Residential Program by Director

Immediate Expulsions

- ❑ Possession of firearms, knives, firecrackers, gunpowder, and other explosive materials
- ❑ Possession of control substances such as illegal drugs and/or alcohol
- ❑ verbal or physical harassment of residential staff/students and or faculty after initial warning
- ❑ Leaving the USC campus or residential facility without permission (Stay In Bounds)
- ❑ Involvement in a physical altercation
- ❑ Stealing

Immediate Expulsions Cont...



- Vandalism or tagging on university property
- Inappropriate behavior with other students
- Breaking 11:00 p.m. curfew
- Intentions of physically harming another student or staff
- Being present in unauthorized area. For examples:
opposite sex dorm area
